

It has changed our lives completely. It not only made us dependent to some extent, but also on a small device. So, it is obvious to know the advantages and disadvantages of smartphones.




What is a smartphone?

- We can <u>search for any information on the internet</u> at any time. This is probably the best use of smartphones.




- Smartphones bring lots of <u>social media platforms</u>, like WhatsApp. It helps us get connected to our family and friends and share information easily.
